

Scholarships for MA Double Degree students

Students aiming for the double degree track of our Master's programme *Religion in the Public Sphere* can now apply for **one of six full scholarships from the German Academic Exchange Service**.

The scholarships are designed to support students financially during their stay at one of the programme's partner universities (Södertörns Högskola Stockholm, Università Roma Tre) and will be awarded for the duration of their studies there. There are three scholarships available for each partner university.

The scholarship comprises grants for living costs, as well as travel and insurance costs. The amount is determined by the duration of the stay as well as monthly rates for the respective country set by the German Academic Exchange Service. They can be found at:

To apply for a scholarship, students are asked to provide **additional documents** to be submitted together with their application for a place on the double degree track:

- Recent Transcript of records from LUH
- For German or EU students: copy of passport
- For non-EU students: copy of visa and copy of certificate of registration in Germany
- Optional: further information such as relevant language certificates, proof of extra-curricula engagement

Application deadline is January 15th, 2025. Please submit all documents in print to Lucie Gott.

Applicants will be notified of the result of their application by February 28th, 2025.
